Group Rate: \$60/night (you can't beat this for a Marriott!) ***If additional days are needed (rate available). It's easier to call - the website only shows the block rates for March 11th-16th for the EAGALA Annual Conference. Deadline for group rate reservations: Feb. 26th Free internet, pool and restaurant.

Directions: From Marriott go west to Wall Ave. Turn right at Wall Ave. You will be heading north. Go to 12th Street. Turn left at 12th Street. You will be heading west. Continue on 12th street all the way under the freeway and until you come to 1900 west or SR126. There will be a stoplight. Turn right at 1900 West. You will be heading north. Go to 1800 north. It will be the second stoplight. Approximately 3 miles. At 1800 north turn left. You will be heading west. Stay on that road. At approximately 3 miles you will come to a Chevron Convenience Store on the right at 4100 West. You are getting close. Continue going west. My house is the 6th house from the Convenience Store on the same side of the road. It has a white vinyl fence in the front. It is the only house that sets back off the road. There is a paved driveway and it will say KEELER on the mailbox.

From Airport: Head north on I-15 towards Ogden. You will be traveling on I-15 for about 30 miles. From I-15 take exit 346. It will say 450 North. It is the next exit after 12th Street. After exiting turn left and go back under the freeway to the first stoplight. It will say SR126 or 2000 West. Turn right. You will be heading north. Go to the next stoplight about 1.5 miles. It will say 1800 North. Turn Left at that stoplight. My house is approximately 3 miles west on that same road. Follow the above directions.

Clothing: It can be very cold in March. Wear layers. Remember to bring gloves, hat and warm boots. We will be in an indoor arena. There will be a wood-burning stove in the observation room, but it can still get cold when working with the horses.
